

## LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENCY STUDENTS

### Policy

It is the policy of the Canaan School District to ensure that students whose primary or dominant language is not English, and who therefore have limited-English proficiency (LEP), have equitable access to school programs as required by law.

### Implementation

The superintendent or his or her designee shall be responsible for developing and implementing procedures to comply with federal and state laws, which define standards for serving LEP students.
