1. A motion was made by Renee Marchesseault seconded by Linda Harris to approve the FY23 Canaan School District Proposed Budget of \$4,518,062; vote 5-0, motion passed.
2. A motion was made by Laurent Giroux seconded by Krista Rodrigue to Approve the Canaan School District Warning as written; vote 5-0, motion passed.

ARTICLE I. Shall the voters of the Canaan School District approve the school board to expend \$4,518,062 which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$21,400 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 6.01% higher than for the current year.

3. A motion was made by Renee Marchesseault seconded by Krista Rodrigue to approve the Three-Year Transportation Proposal from JJ’s Bus Service, Inc.; vote 5-0, motion passed.
